Prince George

It is a centre for forestry; however, with the recent economic boom and the increasing demand for natural resources, especially from Asia, Prince George Airport is spending \$4.5 to \$7.5 million to extend its runway to facilitate larger international cargo and passenger aircrafts, and that is exactly the fundamentals in a town that real estate investors look for.

Driving around town you can see a lot of economic developments in the city, most noticeable is a very large Walmart recently opened right next to Canada's largest Canadian Tire in a strip mall that opened in the last two years.
